

Remote Learning – video conferencing protocols

Recommended and supported video conferencing platforms for WRSC

- Webex – teacher/class, teacher/student

Students are reminded that while communicating with other students and WRSC staff through Compass, Webex, email and Teams the DET's [Acceptable use policy of ICT resources](#) is to be adhered to.

As a student at WRSC, while video conferencing with staff and students, the following protocols are to be followed:

- Students must follow usual school protocols around language and communication.
- Students must be appropriately clothed when participating in all online learning environments.
- For video, students should check that their background is suitable for a learning environment and does not contain any inappropriate material.
- Webex is only to be used during school hours (8:50am – 3:06pm Monday – Friday). For communication outside these times, please only use email/Compass (as we would when school is running normally).
- The staff member will always be the 'host' of any online meeting/class with students.
- Students cannot be compelled to join a video meeting/class. For various reasons (privacy, minimal access to technology/wifi, etc) these must be 'opt-in' only. A student may join a video class with their camera switched off.
- Students must NOT use platforms like Facebook, Snapchat, Facetime, Instagram, Twitter, etc to communicate with staff.
